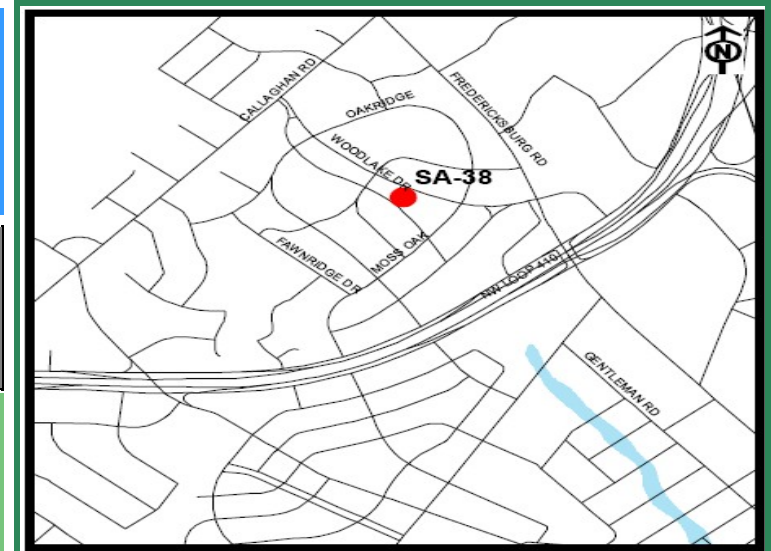
Location / Limits: Oak Hills Park ~ Lakeridge Ave. to Moss Oak Ave.



SCOPE :

The purpose of this project is to alleviate flooding in the City of Balcones Heights by constructing a Regional Storm Water Facility in the southern portion of Oak Hills Park near Fredericksburg Rd. and IH 410. The project is intended to be a grass-lined facility that requires grading of a portion of City of San Antonio Park Property. The intention is to reestablish a park in the regraded facility.
